

- ❖ Weekend: Saturdays and Sundays
 - Arrival: 10:30 – 10:40 am
 - Classes: 10:45 am - 1:30 pm
 - Dhuhr: 1:35 pm
 - Dismissal: 1:50 pm

Parents will drop and pick students from the carpool line and are requested NOT come into the school during the drop off and pick up times. Parents will be RESPONSIBLE for their children's safety after 2:00 pm as **No Adult Supervision** is available after 2:00 pm.

- ❖ After-School: Monday & Wednesday
OR
Tuesdays & Thursdays
 - Arrival: 5:55 pm
 - Classes: 6:00 to 7:30 pm
 - Dismissal: 7:30 pm

Classes Offered

Each of the following is a 1 Hour Class meeting 4 times a month. These classes are specially designed for Public, Private or Home school students that are not regularly exposed to Islamic or Qur'anic Studies. Parents must choose any 3 of the following. Each class costs \$35 a month and enrollment in 3 of these classes is required.

Main Islamic/Qur'anic Studies Tracks:

- ❖ Adab/ Akhlaq/Fiqh
- ❖ Qur'anic Arabic
- ❖ Seerah, Hadith

Other Choices: *Students in KG and 1st Grade are encouraged to focus more on the recitation of the Qur'an so that once they are fluent in reading they can go into the Islamic/Qur'anic studies and Qur'an Memorization classes from 2nd grade on.*

- ❖ Qur'an Recitation (Nazira)
- ❖ Qur'anic Memorization (Hifz)
- ❖ Arabic Language
- ❖ Arts & Crafts

Special Tracks:

- ❖ Professional Soccer, Tennis or Basketball Coaching
 - Offered Saturdays and Sundays for 2 hours between 10:00 am 2:00 pm. Students can sign up for a 2 hours slot that meets 4 times a month. The tuition is \$80 a month.

- ❖ Math & Core Subjects Tutoring for Homework Help
 - Offered on the Weekend and After-School. Each individual 1 hour session is \$20 a month and students must enroll in a minimum of three 1 hour tutoring sessions or three separate one hour tracks a month.

- ❖ Language Classes (Bengali, Spanish, Turkish, Urdu and others per community interest). Please specify your interest on the registration form.

Tuition and Fees

- ❖ \$35 for each 1 Hour track meeting 4 times a month. Minimum enrollment in 3 tracks required.
- ❖ \$80 for each 2 Hours Professional Sports Coaching class meeting 4 times a month.
- ❖ \$20 for each individual 1 Hour Tutoring Session. Minimum enrollment in 3 sessions or 3 tracks required.
- ❖ Sibling Discount: 2nd Child: 10%, 3rd Child: 20%, 4th Child: 30% and so on.

Admission Requirements

- ✓ Every part of the application form must be completed.
- ✓ A separate form must be filled out for each child except that the Parent/Guardian information can be completed on one of the forms.
- ✓ The emergency card must be completed for each child.
- ✓ Minimum enrollment in 3 tracks required. Exception may be made for parents paying full time Islamic school tuition and for children with special/medical needs per the administrator's discretion.
- ✓ A \$100 non-refundable Instructional Materials Fee and the first month's tuition must be submitted with the application to reserve a seat.
- ✓ A 60 days notice is required for withdrawal from the program
